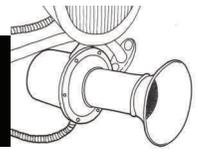





Q: Where was the world's first three-color traffic lights installed?




A: Detroit, Michigan in 1919. Two years later they experimented with synchronized lights.


